Dinesh D'Souza is a bestselling author and filmmaker. His latest film, *Hillary's America* was the #1 documentary of 2016. His films, *2016: Obama's America* and *America: Imagine A World Without Her*, are respectively the #2 and #6 highest political documentaries of all time.

Born in Mumbai, India, Dinesh has truly lived the American Dream. He moved to the United States to attend school on a Rotary Scholarship. Following graduation from Dartmouth University he went on to work in the Reagan White House as a policy analyst. D'Souza has served as a John M. Olin Fellow at the American Enterprise Institute, and Robert and Karen Rishwain Fellow at Stanford University.

D'Souza has won numerous awards including "Best Documentary" for *America* (The Dove Foundation), and he has been called one of the "top young public-policy makers in the country" by *Investor's Business Daily*. Dinesh's books, *Hillary's America* and *The Secret History of the Democratic Party*, *America: Imagine The World Without Her* and *2016: Obama's America*, were #1 on the New York Times bestseller list.

His most recent book, *Death of a Nation: Plantation Politics and the Making of the Democratic Party*, released in July of 2018, hit #5 on the NYT bestseller list. D'Souza's new movie, *Death of a Nation*, was released August 3rd, 2018 in over 1,000 theaters nationwide.
